**A31 Road Marking Renewal**

I am writing to advise that Kier Highways, on behalf of Highways England, will be renewing the road markings along the A31 in Hampshire and Dorset during June and July, to ensure road user's safety.

For the safety of our workforce and customers, we will be closing the A31 overnight (between 9pm and 6am) as follows:

Monday 4 June 2018	A31 east and westbound carriageways between the Merley Roundabout and Sturminster Marshall (A350 Roundhouse Roundabout)  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A341, A349 Gravel Hill, A350 and Poole Road
Wednesday 6 and Thursday 7 June 2018	A31 east and westbound carriageways between Bere Regis and Sturminster Marshall (A350 Roundhouse Roundabout)  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A35 and A350
Monday 11 June 2018	A31 east and westbound carriageways between the Canford Bottom junction and the Merley roundabout  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via Ham Lane, Ringwood Road and A341 Magna Road
Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 June 2018	A31 east and westbound carriageways between the Canford Bottom junction and the Palmersford roundabout  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via Wimborne Road East/West

Wednesday 27 and Thursday 28 June	A31 westbound carriageway from junction 2 of the M27 to the A338 Ashley Heath roundabout  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via Lyndhurst, the A35, Christchurch and the A338
Monday 2 and Tuesday 3 July 2018	A31 eastbound carriageway from the A338 Ashley Heath roundabout to the M27 (junction 1)  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A338 Christchurch, the A35 and Lyndhurst
Thursday 5 July	A31 eastbound carriageway from the Palmersford roundabout to the Boundary Lane roundabout  During the closures a clearly signed diversion will be in place via the Ringwood Road, East Parley and the A338
Friday 6 July	A31 westbound carriageway from the Boundary Lane roundabout to the Palmersford roundabout  A31 between the Palmersford roundabout and the Boundary Lane roundabout

Access will be maintained for any resident or business where their property is directly off the A31 and for emergency service vehicles only.

Please be aware that these works have been carefully programmed but are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances – **please check the yellow signs placed in advance at the junction for confirmation of the closures dates/timings.**

It is not expected that these works will generate excessive noise, however we would like to apologise in advance for any disturbance caused during the works.
