



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A338, BLACKWATER JUNCTION, SOUTHBOUND SLIP ROADS, CHRISTCHURCH

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A338, BLACKWATER JUNCTION, SOUTHBOUND SLIP ROADS. The closures will apply to [1] A338, Southbound off slip from the A338 to the junction with the B3073, Hurn Road and [2] The A338 Southbound on slip from the junction with B3073, Hurn Road to the A338, total distance of approximately 600 metres. The notice is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on [1] 4th September 2017 at 20:00hrs and will remain in force until 05th September 2017 at 06:00hrs; and [2] 05th September 2017 at 20:00hrs and will remain in force until 06th September 2017 at 06:00hrs; and [3] 06th September 2017 at 20:00hrs and will remain in force until 07th September 2017 at 06:00hrs. The road will be open outside of these times. This notice can be extended upto a maximum of 5 days.

This notice will enable Dorset County Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
