



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DUDSBURY ROAD, FERNDOWN

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Dudsbury Road, Ferndown from the junction with Glenmoor Road, to the junction with Ellesfield Drive, a distance of approximately 550 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 28th September 2017 and remain in force for 5 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3rd October 2017. The closure will be in operation between 09:00hrs and 16:00hrs daily, and the road will be re-opened over the weekend.

This Notice will enable Dorset County Council safe access to carry out resurfacing works, in the highway

A locally signed diversion route will be placed to enable travel around the closed section.
