TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BIRCH AVENUE & OAKLAND WALK, WEST PARLEY

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Birch Avenue from its junction with Oakland Walk a distance of approximately 280 metres and Oakland Walk from its junction with A347 New Road a distance of approximately 180 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 6th September 2019 between 09:00 and 16:30 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9th September 2019.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

Please note that the dates are a window of opportunity and the road may not be closed for the whole duration stated above and the works are weather dependant. There will be no locally signed diversion route in this instance. Access will be maintained for emergency services and residents.
