

## OVER NIGHT TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, RINGWOOD ROAD, FERNDOWN

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Notice comes in to operation on 14th December 2021 between 20:00 and 06:00 and will remain in force for 5 nights, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16th December 2021. The road will be open out side of these times as normal.

### This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[i] To impose temporary road closure on Ringwood Road, Ferndown, from the junction of Casterbridge Road and the Double Mini Roundabout. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.

[iii] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Ringwood Road, Ferndown, from the junction of Casterbridge Road and the Double Mini Roundabout. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Ham Lane (B3073) - Wimborne Road - Ringwood Road
