

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DUDSBURY ROAD, WEST PARLEY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Dudsbury Road, West Parley between 77 Dudsbury Road and 83 Dudsbury Road, a distance of approximately 30 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation with immediate effect and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7th August 2023.

This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to carry out emergency works to repair a pipe leak.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Linden Road - Christchurch Road
