## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE OF FITZPAIN CLOSE, WEST PARLEY

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:00 - 16:00 on 4th May 2023 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5th May 2023.

## This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:


- [i] To impose temporary road closure of Fitzpain Close, West Parley in its entirety as indicated by signs on site.
- [ii] To impose a clearway and parking suspension to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Fitzpain Close, West Parley in its entirety as indicated by signs on site.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been towed the owner will need to contact our towing contractors Bride Valley on 01305 889421. Please note that the dates are a window of opportunity and the road may not be closed for the whole duration stated above and the works are weather dependant.
