

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LONGHAM BRIDGE, RINGWOOD ROAD, LONGHAM

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Longham Bridge, Ringwood Road, Longham a distance of approximately 100 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 10:00 and 14:00 on 28th March 2023 and can remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28th March 2023. Access will be maintained on Ringwood Road either side of the hard closure at Longham Bridge, however there will be no through route between Longham Double Mini Roundabout and Bear Cross Roundabout.

This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to carry out urgent investigative works to a burst main on Longham Bridge.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: A341 - A349 - A31 - B3073 and vice versa
