

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, LONGHAM (OVERNIGHT)

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Various Roads, Longham as listed: [i] Ringwood Road between Pompeys Lane and Old Post Office as indicated by signs on site; [ii] Christchurch Road at its junction with Ringwood Road as indicated by signs on site. [iii] Ham Lane at its junction with Ringwood Road as indicated by signs on site. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It came into operation on 29th October 2023 and remains in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 19:00 - 06:00 on 7th January 2024 until 12th January 2024. The road(s) will be open outside of these times. This Order can be extended with approval of the Secretary of State.

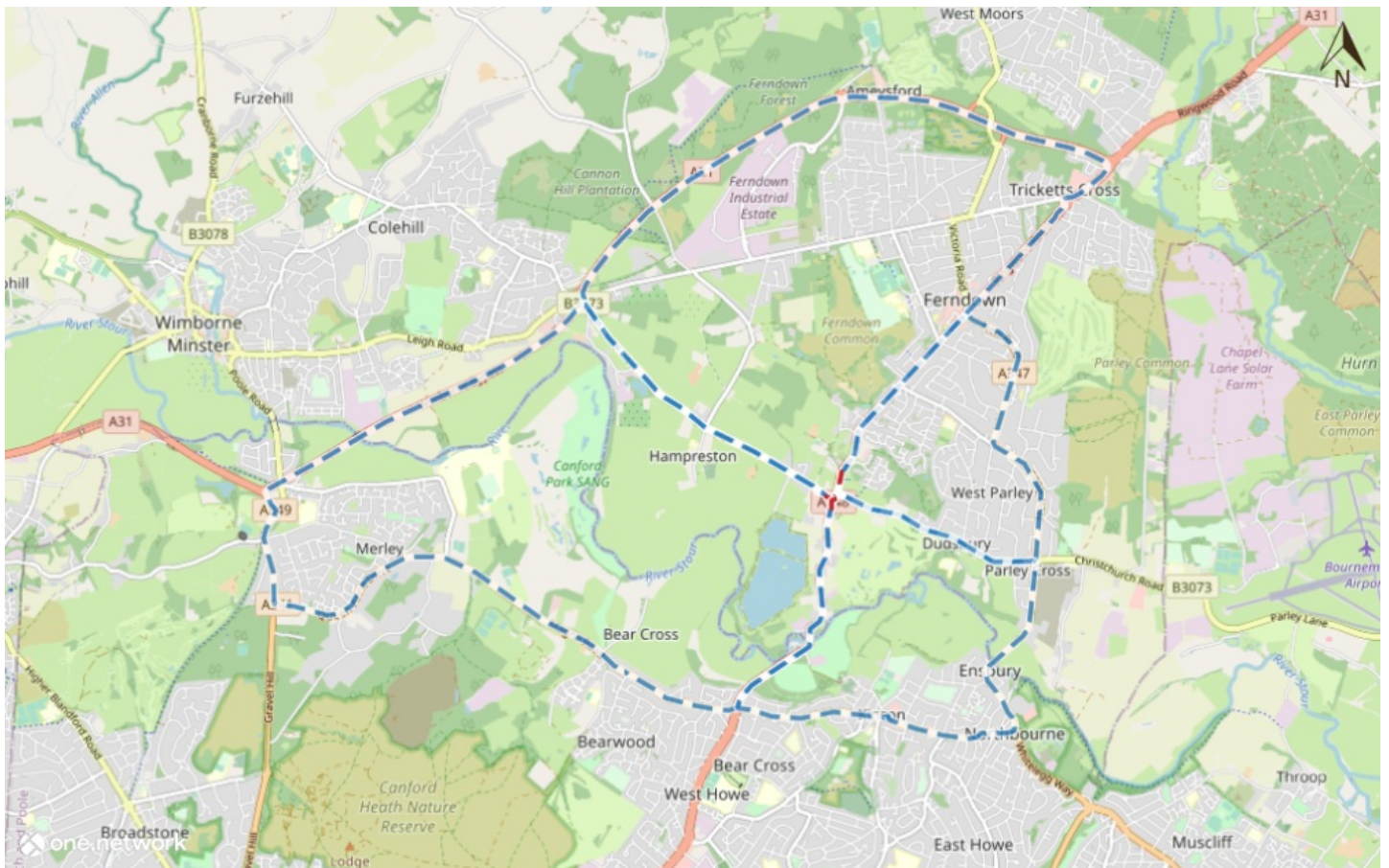
This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out drainage works.
