

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, VARIOUS ROADS, WEST PARLEY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Order comes into operation on 3rd July 2023 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7th July 2023.

This Order will enable Gracelands Ltd safe access to carry out resurfacing works in the highway.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on; CHRISTCHURCH ROAD, WEST PARLEY - Westbound only between its junction with Parley Close and its junction with New Road between 06:00 - 20:00 as indicated by signs on site

[ii] To impose a temporary road closure on; CHRISTCHURCH ROAD, WEST PARLEY - Full closure Westbound and Eastbound between its junction with Parley Close and its junction with New Road between 20:00 - 06:00 as indicated by signs on site

[iii] To impose a temporary road closure on; PARLEY CLOSE, WEST PARLEY - Full closure at its junction with Christchurch Road between 20:00 - 06:00 as indicated by signs on site

The alternative routes, which will be sign posted are as follows:

[i] B3073 - A338 - A3060 - A347

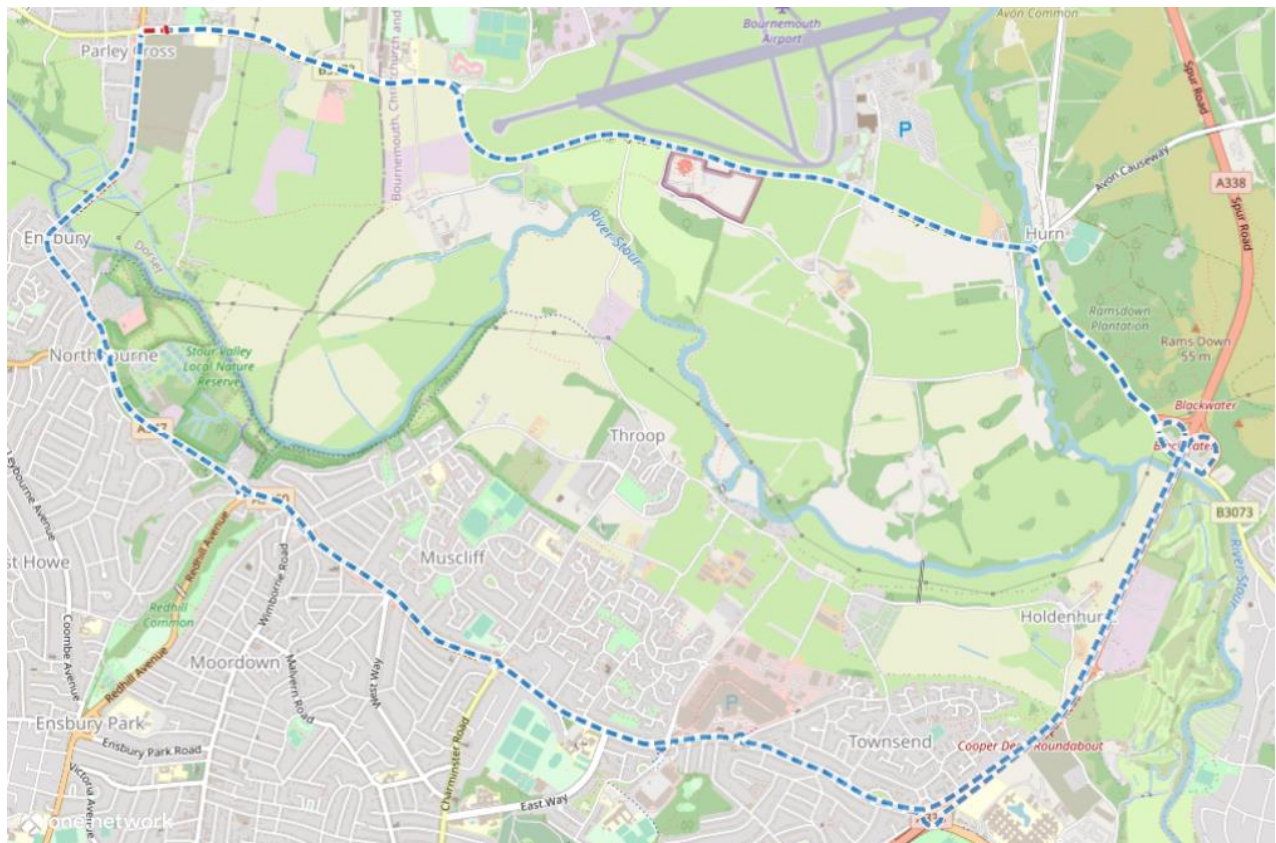
[ii] B3073 - A338 - A3060 - A347 and vice versa

[iii] On this occasion there will be no signed alternative route.
