

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DUDSBURY ROAD (ACCESS SECTION FROM A347), WEST PARLEY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles, cyclists and horse riders will be prohibited from proceeding along DUDSBURY ROAD (ACCESS FROM A347), WEST PARLEY between A347 and Dudsbury Road, a distance of approximately 10 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 24 March 2025 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 March 2025.

This Notice will enable SGN safe access to carry out emergency gas repairs.

Locally signed diversion routes will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
